P.R.I.D.E. Expectations

- I: Integrity - Complete any assignments or tasks to the best of your ability. Be honest when questioned about how much assistance you may have received on some assignments.
- D: Dependability - Keep up with materials and due dates for class. Replace any materials you borrow in the same place and/or condition.
- E: Excellence - Straighten up your area and the classroom when instruction ends. Volunteer for leadership or service roles in class.

Restroom Policy

Students will be using MINGA this year to monitor time outside the classroom. Students in World History class will be allowed four (4) restroom passes during each grading quarter. Due to alternating days, students will only have 22 class meetings for instruction each quarter. Being in class is SUPER important. Students are encouraged to visit the restroom during class change or other times during the day in which they will not miss critical instructional time.
