Recognizing the challenges faced by military recruiters, the No Child Left Behind Law requires high schools to provide to military recruiters, upon request, access to names, addresses, and phone numbers of high school juniors and seniors. The law also requires high schools to release information to colleges or other higher learning institutions, upon request.

If you do not want Lee County Schools to disclose this information to the military and/or college recruiters, please complete the lower portion of this letter and return it to the high school. If we do not receive the form back by, we will release student directory information to military or college recruiters upon request. If your child is over 18, he or she must sign the form.
